## ◆ STICKS AND LIMBS

As a courtesy, the Wolcott Street Department will now collect sticks, limbs, branches and brush according to the following guidelines set forth by the Council of the Town of Wolcott:

- If any naturally fallen sticks, limbs & branches are outside the parameters stated below, please contact Street Superintendent, Robert Thomas at (219) 863-8758.
- Nothing over 4 inches in diameter.
- No limbs over 8 feet long.
- Pile is not to exceed 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 8 ft.
- Limit of one (1) pile per collection day.
- Place all sticks, limbs, braches and brush in the easement (not in the street) with ends facing the road way.
- No root ball from bushes.
- No trash, lumber or building materials.
- The Street Department will not be responsible for collection of any remains of a tree trimming, tree or trees that have been cut down or removed by a tree removal company/contractor.
- Piling of sticks, limbs, branches and brush at dead ends is prohibited. The Street Department will only be responsible for collection of debris on individual properties.
- Collection of sticks, limbs, branches and brush will be **every Monday; March through November.**
- Resident will be notified of any guideline violation and given the opportunity to correct the violation. Upon correction of the violation, the Street Department will collect the stick, limb, branch and brush pile on the collection day following the correction of the violation.



◆ **TRASH PICK UP** Trash pick up is on Thursday...Trash can be put out NO earlier than noon on Wednesday and MUST be out by 6:00 a.m. Thursday. Trash Bag/Receptacle Limit respectively 6 Bags/2 Receptacles.

**All receptacles must be removed from curbside by dusk Thursday Night.** If you have a large item to be picked up, YOU must call Advanced Disposal at 574-808-4665.

**Advanced Disposal WILL NOT pick-up the following items:**

- 👉 APPLIANCES
- 👉 TV'S (CONTAIN MERCURY)
- 👉 TIRES
- 👉 BUILDING MATERIALS
- 👉 ANYTHING OVER 50 POUNDS
- 👉 YARD WASTE i.e. GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, STICKS, LIMBS, BRANCHES, ETC.

## LEAF PICK-UP

### *Notice to Wolcott Residents*

### *Burning of leaves is not allowed in the Town of Wolcott*



Violators will be cited - no exceptions!

The Wolcott Street Department will begin vacuuming leaves Monday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, and each **MONDAY** thereafter. There will be no doubling back for piles that appear after your street has been cleared of leaves. Please rake leaves to the street easement - that is the property between the sidewalk and the street. If you don't have a sidewalk, the leaves should be two feet from the street edge. All leaf piles should be four feet from poles or mailboxes, etc. Rake leaves in a narrow row and not in a pile. The vac hose cannot reach beyond 4 feet from the street edge. Remember, leaves, and leaves only, will be collected. Any pile of leaves found with debris in it will be left for the resident to clear away. Debris includes, sticks, brush, grass clippings, trash, paper etc.
